THE GRADING SYSTEM

- OUR PROGRAMMES ARE STRUCTURED ACCORDING TO THE **EUROPEAN CREDIT TRANSFER AND ACCUMULATION SYSTEM** (ECTS).
- FRENCH HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS USE A NUMERIC SCALE OUT OF 20. THE MINIMUM PASSING GRADE IS 10/20.
- OUR PROGRAMMES USUALLY TOTAL 30 ECTS CREDITS, STUDENTS CAN ADAPT THEIR COURSE SELECTION TO FIT THEIR HOME UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS UP TO TWO WEEKS AFTER THE BEGINNING OF COURSES (ADD&DROP PERIOD).
